

Educational facility uses grant funds to expand nursing simulation spaces with cost-effective equipment from DRE

Founded in 1972, Baldy View ROP is a public school agency, accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges, that provides career and technical education to California's adult and high school populations.

Baldy View is part of the West End Corridor Consortium, a 2017 recipient of the Career Technical Education Grant awarded by the California Department of Education. Utilizing the awarded funds, Baldy View expanded its Vocational Nursing Program facilities.

The work required the refurbishment of two spaces, Baldy View ROP and Upland High School, in order to convert or update them into the medical simulation laboratories.
